### TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Most chemical food ingredients are labelled with a “Best Before” date as a requirement of Food Safety Legislation. Many of the chemicals thus labelled are inert chemical minerals, the properties of which do not change over time; provided that they are stored inside, away from moisture and direct sunlight.

Chemicals included in this category include:

- Diatomaceous Earth
- Calcium Chloride
- Magnesium Sulphate
- Calcium Sulphate
- Sodium Chloride
- Sodium Bicarbonate
- Citric Acid
- Sodium Citrate
- Sodium Tripolyphosphate

While some product settlement may occur during prolonged storage, generally any lumps can be easily broken up and the chemical properties of the product will remain unchanged.
